This qualification is made up of units developed in association with Skills for Health and the Sector Skills Council for the Health and Social Care Sector. It enhances and improves verbal and written communication skills, promotes personal growth and provides basic industry knowledge, preparing learners for progression onto appropriate further qualifications. Learners will complete this qualification with a full and comprehensive understanding of the following:

- How to reflect on personal development and identify areas for future development.
- What core counselling skills are, including how to establish a helping relationship and knowing how to conclude a helping interaction.

RHS LEVEL 2 THEORY QUALIFICATIONS

1. Certificate in The Principles of Garden Planning, Establishment and Maintenance.

2. Certificate in The Principles of Plant Growth, Propagation and Development.

These courses are theory-based qualifications at Level 2 providing a broad knowledge of the principles supporting horticultural practices.

They are for people wanting a route into the horticultural profession, to support career development for those already working in horticulture, or to provide a foundation for further learning or training. They can also, of course, simply provide keen gardeners with further knowledge.

RHS PRACTICAL HORTICULTURE

These qualifications develop the essential skills needed to work in horticulture or to further develop your personal interest.

From Level 1, aimed at anyone with an interest in plants and gardening focusing on developing essential basic horticultural skills, to Level 3 which takes your learning to a much higher level, improving the horticultural skills needed for career development in supervisory or management roles.

COURSE FEES

Courses leading to a qualification

Level 1 and 2 Courses: Fees are waived for 19-23 year olds who do not currently have a full Level 2 qualification and for all learners on JSA, ESA (WRAG) or certain other benefits.

Level 3 Courses: Fees are waived for 19-23 year olds who do not currently have a Level 3 qualification. All other learners must pay their course fees in full or fund the course through the **Advanced Learner Loan**.

The loan works in a similar way to a university student loan and does not have to start being repaid unless or until you are earning over £21,000 per year. For full details go to www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan or contact our Admissions team.

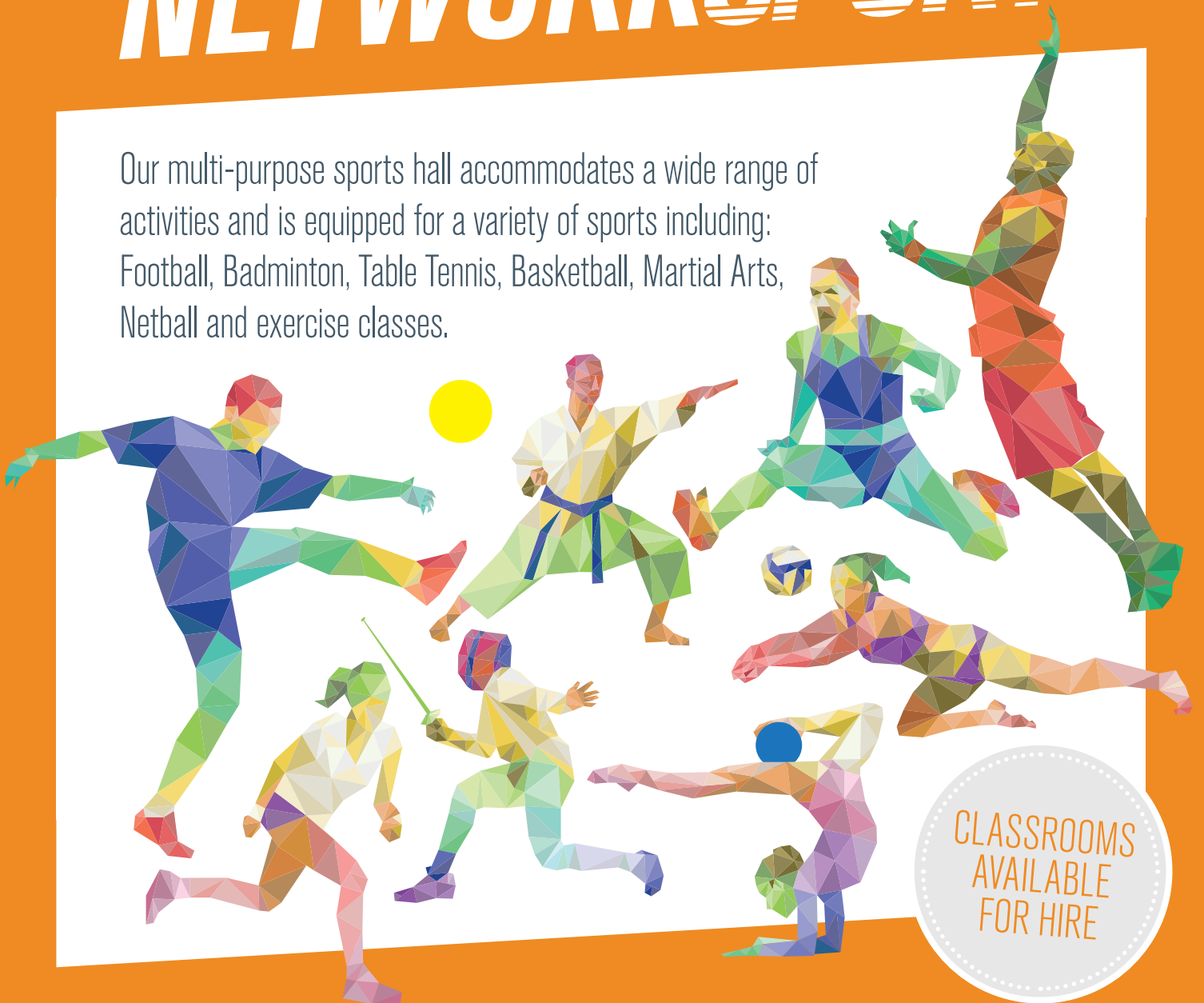
